



EDIBLE TREE DESCRIPTIONS (CITRUS)

- Calamondin – Cold hardy into the teens. Great for Marmalade. Fruit are orange, small, and have a sour taste
- Citron Buddha Hand – Small tree with oblong leaves. 4”-6” fruit that are long and seedless
- Clementine Nules – Sweet and juicy fruit. Easy to peel with a few seeds.
- Grapefruit Bloomsweet – Fruit has white flesh with yellow skin. Very cold hardy and easy to peel.
- Grapefruit Cocktail – Sweet and juicy. Small to medium size fruit. Sweeter and less acidic than standard grapefruit. Has a dark yellow rind with deep yellow flesh. Great for juicing.
- Grapefruit Oro Blonco – Flesh is slightly sweet and tart with a white color. Has thick but easy to peel rind.
- Grapefruit Rio Red – Large fruit with smooth thin skin. Yellow skin with red flesh. Very juicy.
- Grapefruit Ruby Red – Light sweet flavor. This variety is a heavy bearer that requires full sun. Has pink color flesh.
- Kumquat Changshou – Large fruit with a sweet thick rind.
- Kumquat Nagami – Bright orange fruit that are egg shaped. Very cold hardy. Sour taste with tart flesh.
- Kumquat Meiwa – Sweet flavor. Round Fruit. Very cold hardy.
- Lemon Eureka Frost – Vigorous spreading tree. Bears multiple crops per year.
- Lemon Improved Meyer – Compact tree with medium size fruit. Fruit has thin yellow skin and is very juicy.
- Lemon Iranian – Large fruit similar to the ponderosa but much more cold-hardy.
- Lemon Lisbon Seedless – Vigorous grower. Seedless & Juicy.
- Lemon New Zealand – Sweet lemon hybrid with few seeds. Very productive yield.
- Lemon Ponderosa – Large thorny tree that produces very large fruit. Tart taste.
- Lemon Ujukitsu – Variety originated in Japan. Lemon-orange cross. Perfect for making lemonade or other drinks.
- Lemon Variegated Pink – Green, yellow, and white leaves. Fruit is pink in color.
- Australian Finger Lime – Bush form tree that will reach 6’-8’ in height. Known as citrus caviar and has a tart juicy fruit.
- Lime Kaffir – Grown for unique aromatic leaves used in Asian cooking.
- Lime Key Thornless – upright thornless tree. Fruit has thin skin and contains very few seeds.
- Lime Mexican – Thorny and upright tree. Heavy bearer with very juicy fruit.
- Lime Palestinian Sweet – Very juicy fruit that are bland and have a slightly bitter taste.
- Lime Persian – Medium to large juicy fruit. Great for cooking.
- Mandarin Encore – Late ripening variety. Medium size fruit that are easy to peel and have a juicy, rich flavor.

Mandarin Honey – Thin skinned & easy to peel.

Mandarin Kishu – Medium size tree with small, bright orange fruit. Easy to peel with very few seeds.

Mandarin Pixie – Seedless variety. The fruit are sweet and juicy while also being easy to peel.

Mandarin Pong Koa – Medium upright growing tree. Large and sweet fruit. Ripens in November.

Mandarin Ponkan – Medium upright growing tree. Large and sweet fruit. Easy to peel. Ripens in December.

Orange Cara Cara – Light pink flesh that is sweet and juicy. Great for juicing or raw consumption.

Orange Marrs – Navel orange budsport. Low in acid and is a heavy bearer.

Orange Blood Moro – Vigorous tree. Color ranges from light orange to purple. Incredible taste. Customer favorite.

Orange Sanguinelli Blood – Spanish variety of blood orange. Known as one of the best tasting blood oranges.
